MTS National Director Ben Pfahlert is a man on the move. Ben is currently travelling around the country and visiting church groups to promote the "MTS Multiply 500" project.

"Since we introduced the MTS Scholarship Scheme at the beginning of 2014, the cost of taking on a Gospel Apprentice has been significantly reduced," says Ben. "So now is the time to get out and about and spread the good news!"

"The challenge is to get training centres (churches/ministries) to trial the idea of taking on an apprentice. Because we know that in most cases

the practice will continue on because of the positive effect on the apprentice and the ministry."

## The MTS Gospel Growth Plan

The number of MTS Apprentices in Christian ministries across Australia currently sits at around 250. This level of engagement has been relatively stable over the last 5 years.

As a rule, training centres (churches/ministries) that engage MTS Apprentices find them to be a valuable team member and continue to hold the positions open. Conversely, those who don't take on apprentices claim that their main reason for not doing so has been the cost.

This is a situation that has now been addressed through the introduction of the MTS Scholarship. Traditionally, apprentices were classed as employees, and in order to comply with legislation they needed to be paid accordingly.

From now on, the scholarship scheme is able to re-classify the MTS Apprentice as a student, who benefits from MTS' tax-deductible education fund and is able to apply for other Government benefits such as Austudy and living-away-from-home allowance.

The net effect is a reduced cost barrier and more opportunity for gospel growth. Add to this our stimulus package – and see that cost is no longer a real hurdle to a church or ministry appointing an apprentice.

#### The MTS Stimulus Incentive

The incentive scheme both seeks to generate and offer support to ministries as they consider taking on an apprentice. As Multiply 500 moves forward, each state will be set up with its own stimulus fund. Christians across Australia give tax deductible funds to train ministry apprentices in their state. The funds raised will then be distributed in \$4,000 packages to apprentices on the new MTS scholarship system.

Funding for a church/ministry breaks down to be: \$4,000 from the state Multiply 500 Stimulus Fund + \$4,000 from the Church + \$12,000 self funded = \$20,000. With the addition of Austudy, each apprentice will receive a scholarship of \$23,000 p.a.

If you are running a ministry and interested in taking on an apprentice, the MTS Stimulus Incentive could kick-start an MTS gospel growth plan in your ministry.

Alternatively, by contributing to this initiative – "MTS Multiply 500" – you will enable MTS to mount a national campaign to seek out new candidates and placements to multiply it's gospel impact.

"MTS Multiply 500" is a national campaign with a regional emphasis, so that a local ministry that sees the need for an apprentice can be linked up to a local support group.

The stimulus package will have the effect of attracting more people and getting new training centres (churches/ministries) to take that first step in the journey to take on and train up an MTS Apprentice.

## MTS OS: Chile

MTS's ministry has a wide reach both in Australia and overseas. In March 2014 Ben Pfahlert was invited to participate in 'Vocacion'. With the translation assistance from Cesar Guzman, (a Moore College Graduate) Ben spoke at this MTS information event for local pastors and potential apprentices in Chile.

Over 70 people attended and together they shared in Bible teaching, prayer and worship. They also learned about what to expect from being involved in an MTS Apprenticeship, and following the event, 9 of them are considering taking on the challenge. Praise be to God!
