2. To learn skills in meeting people, developing rapport, ascertaining others' religious beliefs and attitudes, presenting the gospel, answering questions and seeking a response.

Apprentices

- Evangelise with your Trainer, Minister or another Christian who has experience in evangelism.
- Try locations such as parks, shopping centres, beaches, the street, markets, tertiary campuses or door-to-door.
- Strategic locations are those near your church or ministry, where it is possible to invite people to meetings.
- Develop some opening questions and a strategy for your conversations.
- Follow-up those interested.
