- Committed to a reformed, evangelical understanding of Scripture and strongly aligned to the confessional theology of the Christian Reformed Churches of Australia (CRCA)
- Able to commit to the mission and vision of Riverbank Christian Church
- Eager to see children and youth grow into mature disciples of Jesus

Skills:
